

The group became an incorporated national collegiate sorority on December 30, 1929, when a charter was granted to the Alpha Chapter at Butler University.

New members of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. are accepted on both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Potential **GRADUATE** members must hold a degree from a four-year accredited educational institution.

An woman may be admitted for membership in an **UNDERGRADUATE** chapter only while in attendance at a four-year accredited college or university, or in a liberal arts/transfer program or a junior or community college .. Once they submit proof of intention to enter and obtain a degree from a four-year school.

Candidates may be accepted for **UNDERGRADU-ATE** membership after successfully completing one quarter, semester or trimester. *The cumulative grade point average required for membership is a 2.5.*
